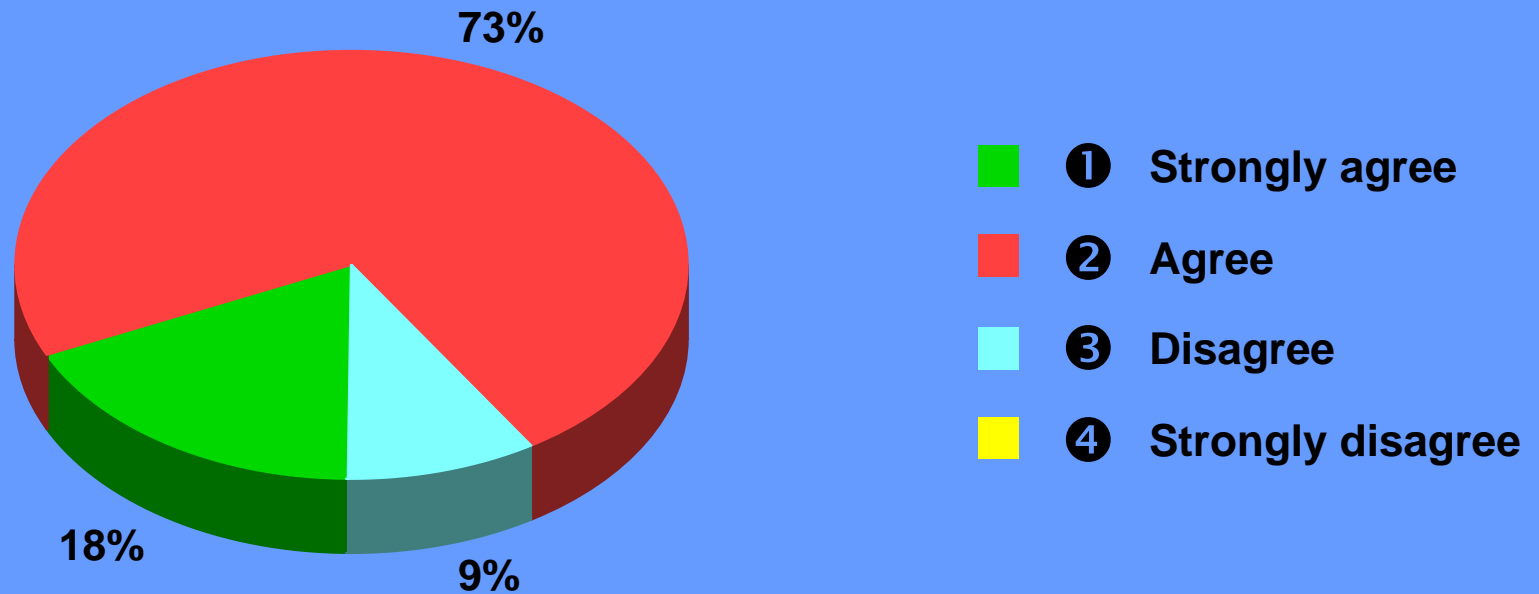
Interactive Voting

- Here are the results of the consultation



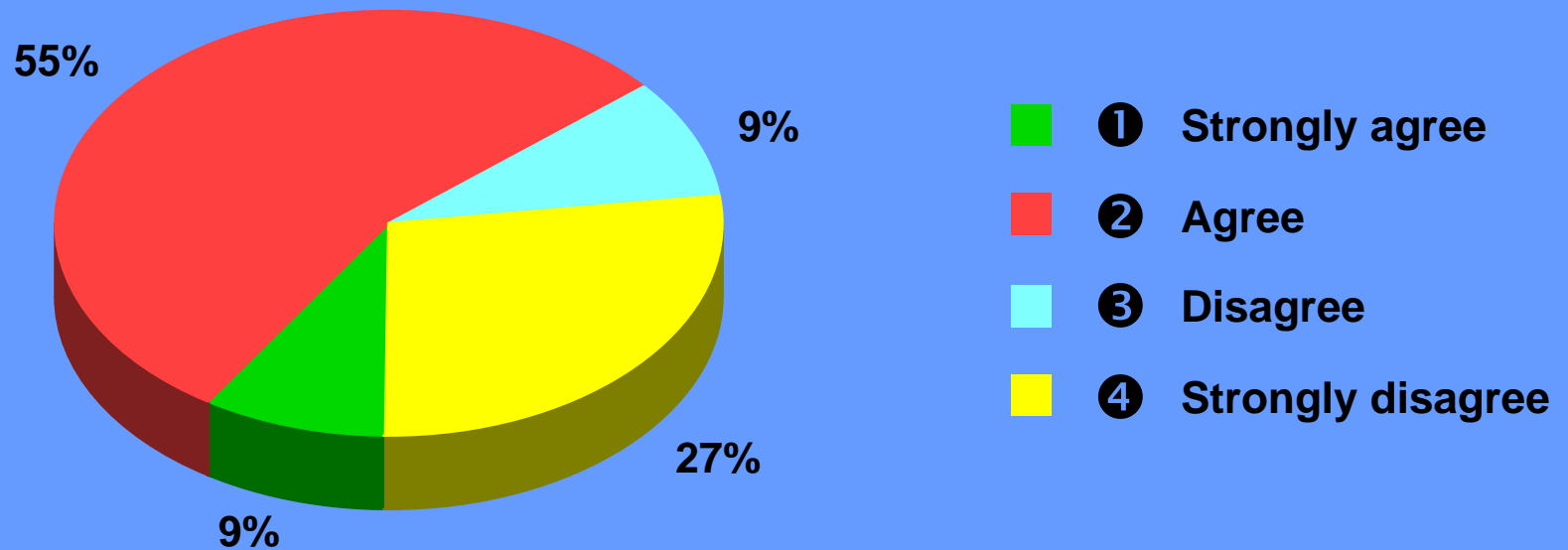

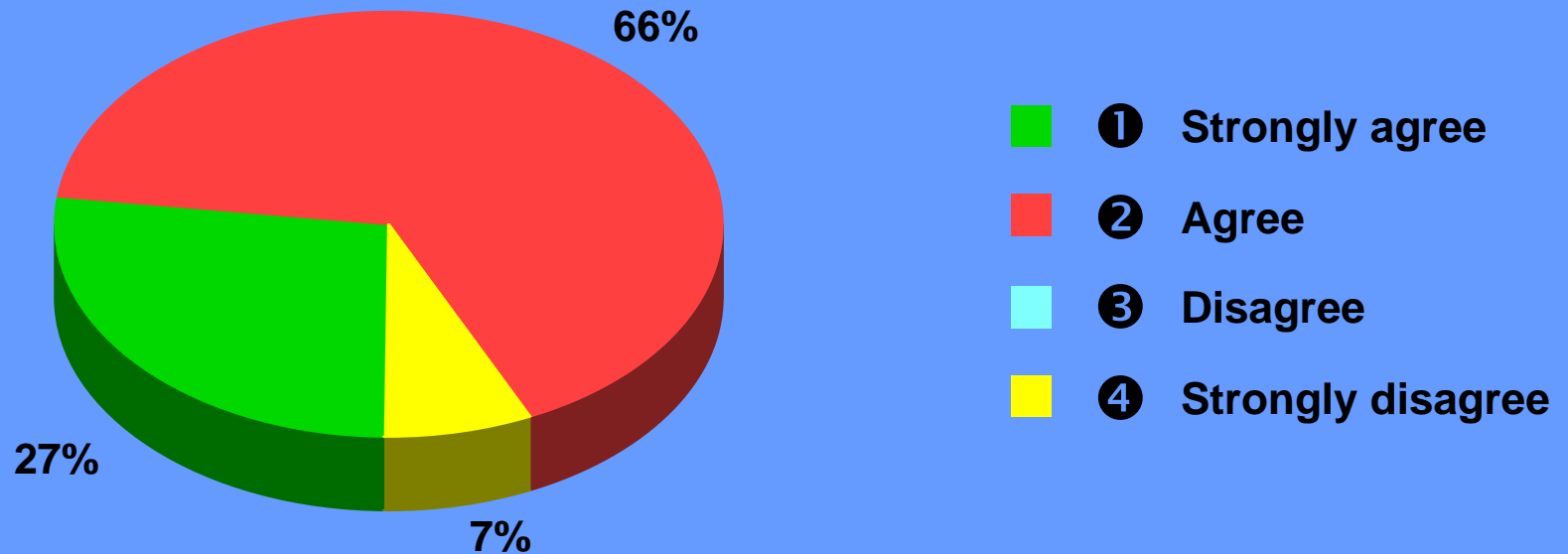

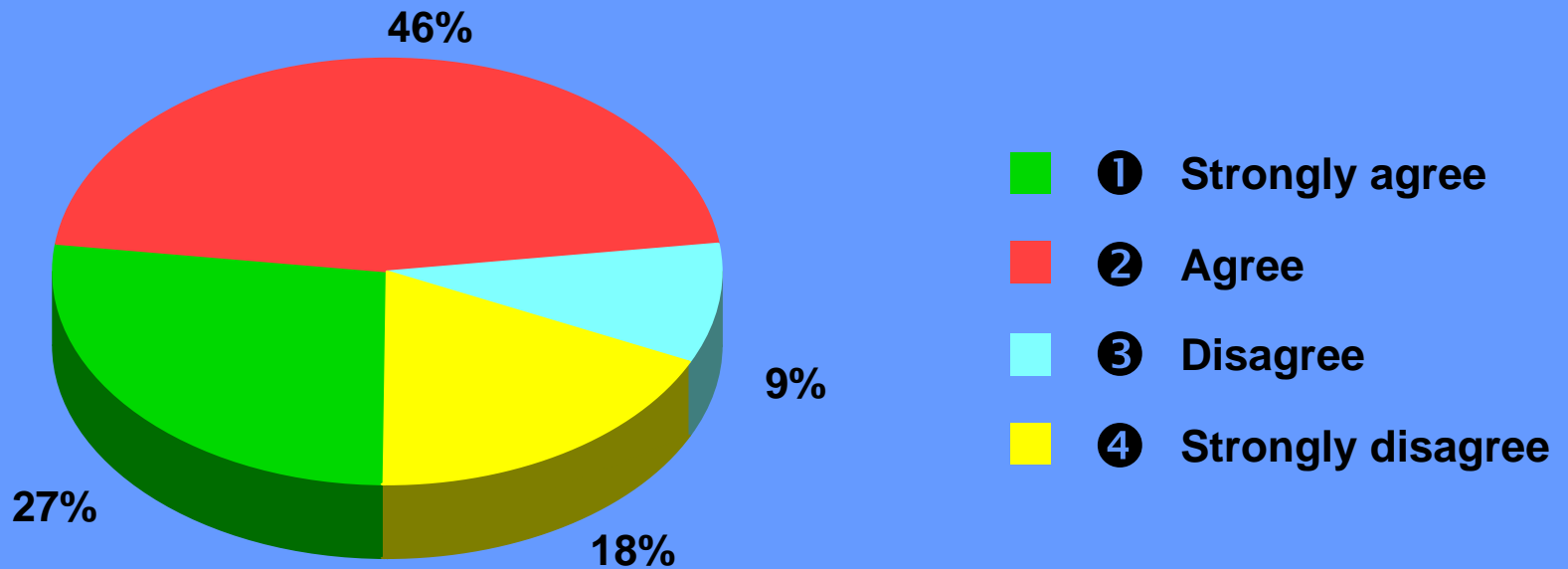

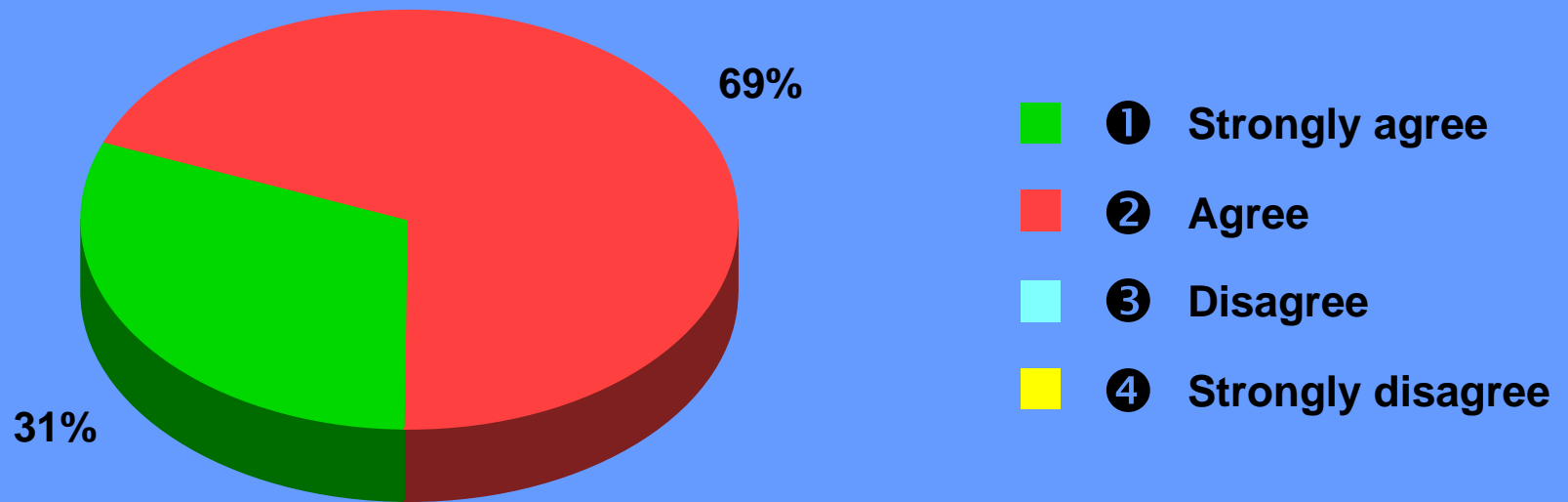

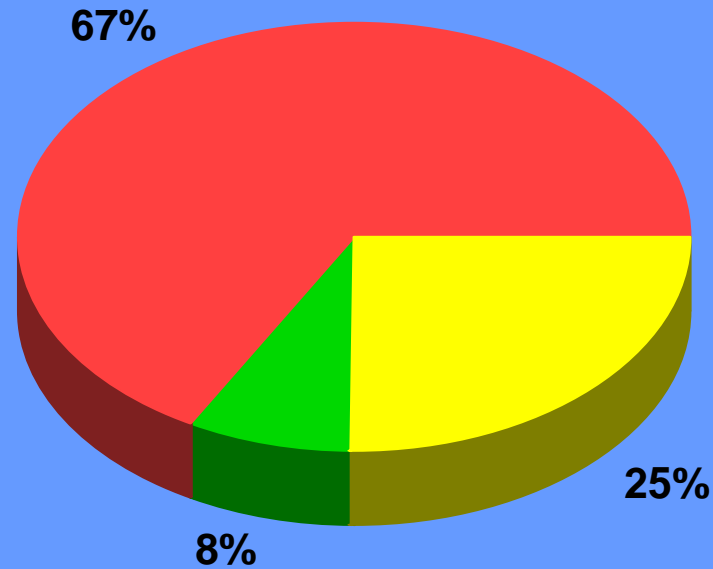

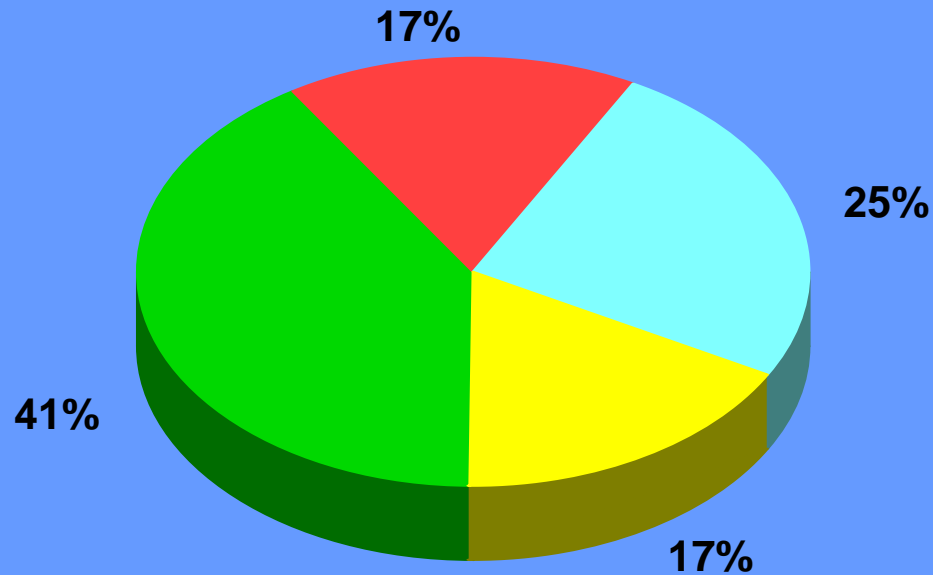

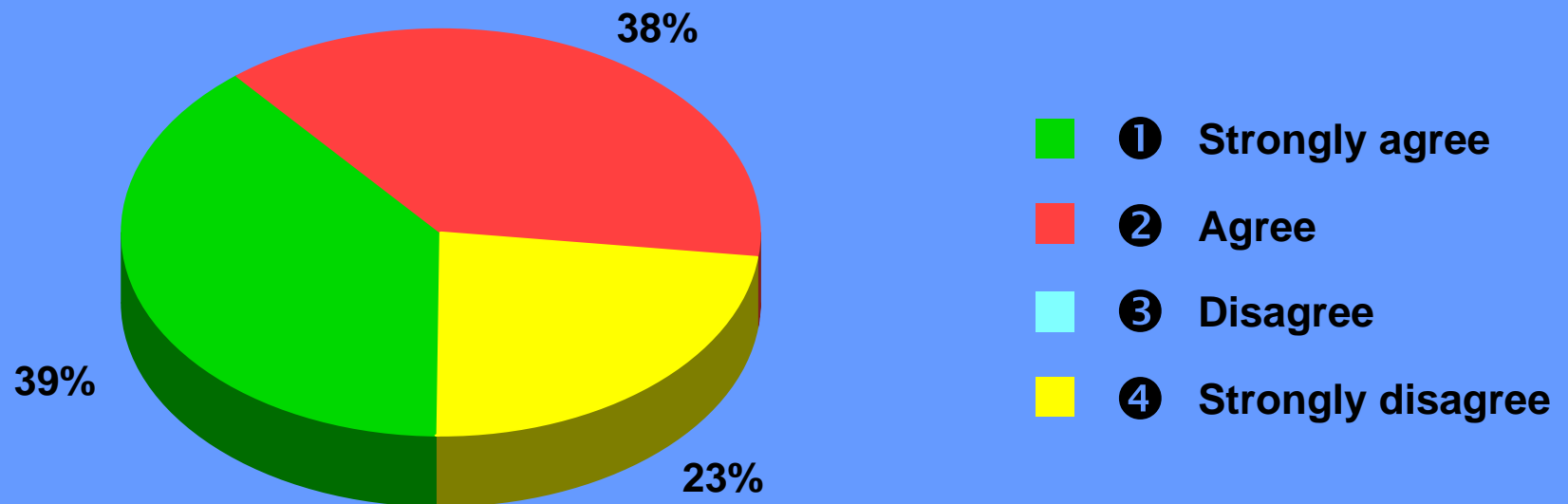

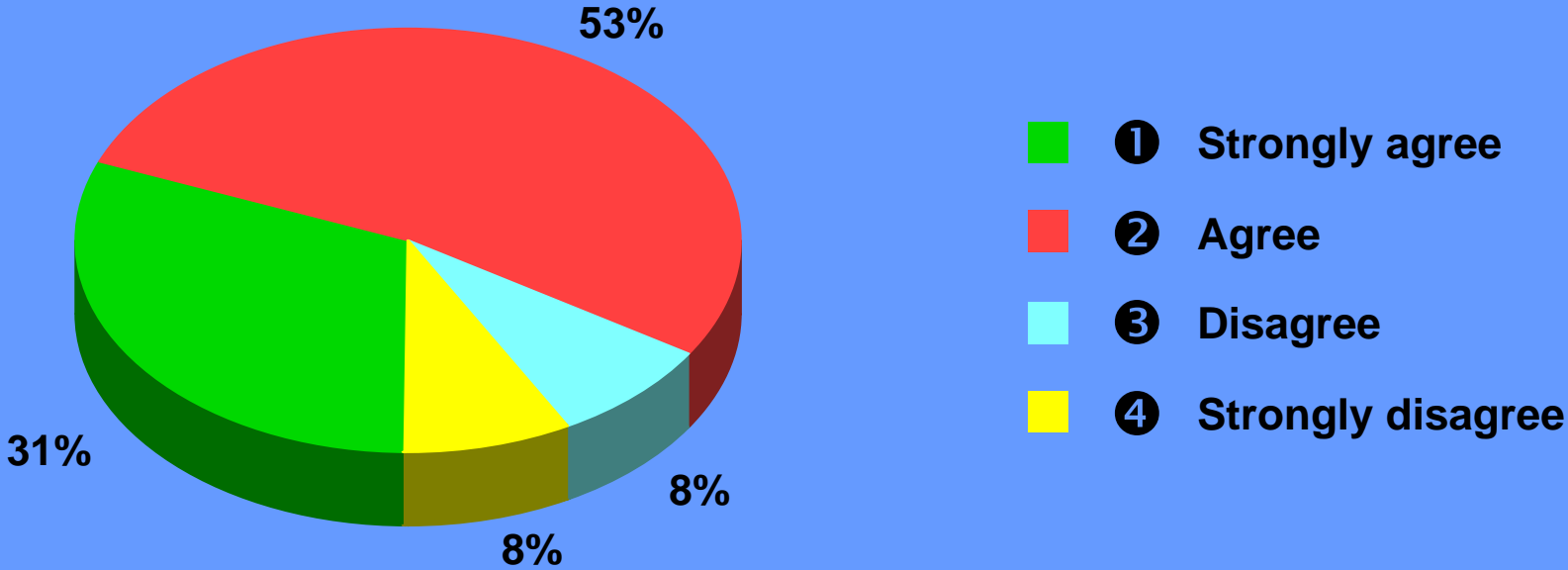

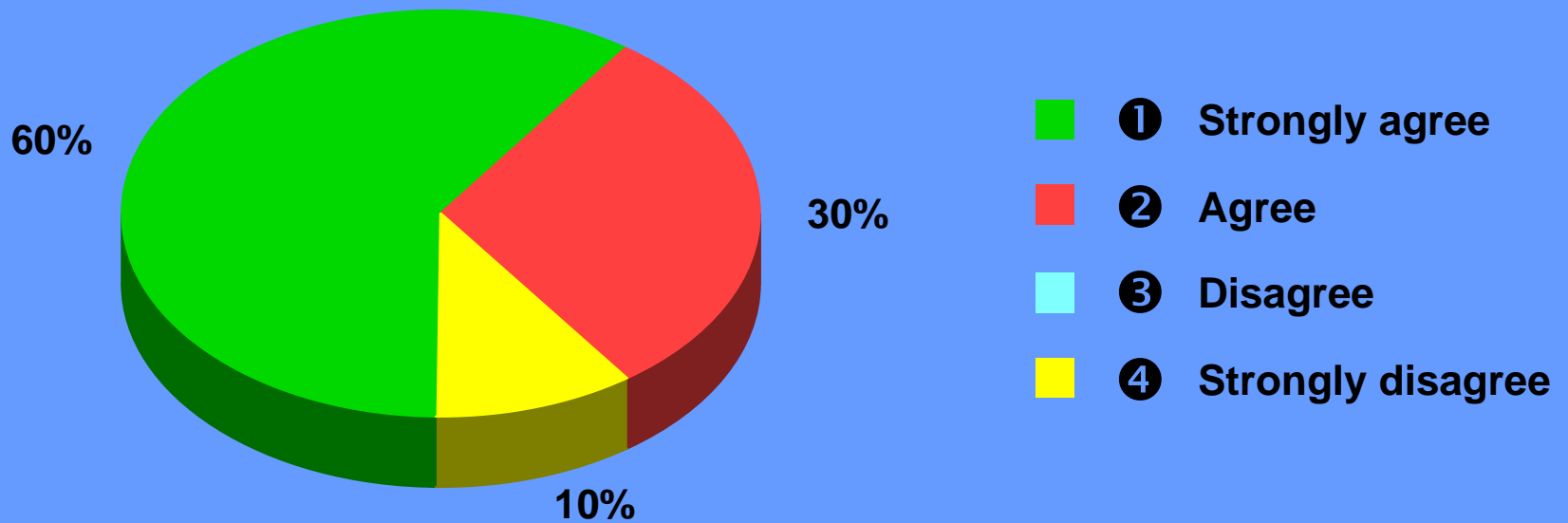

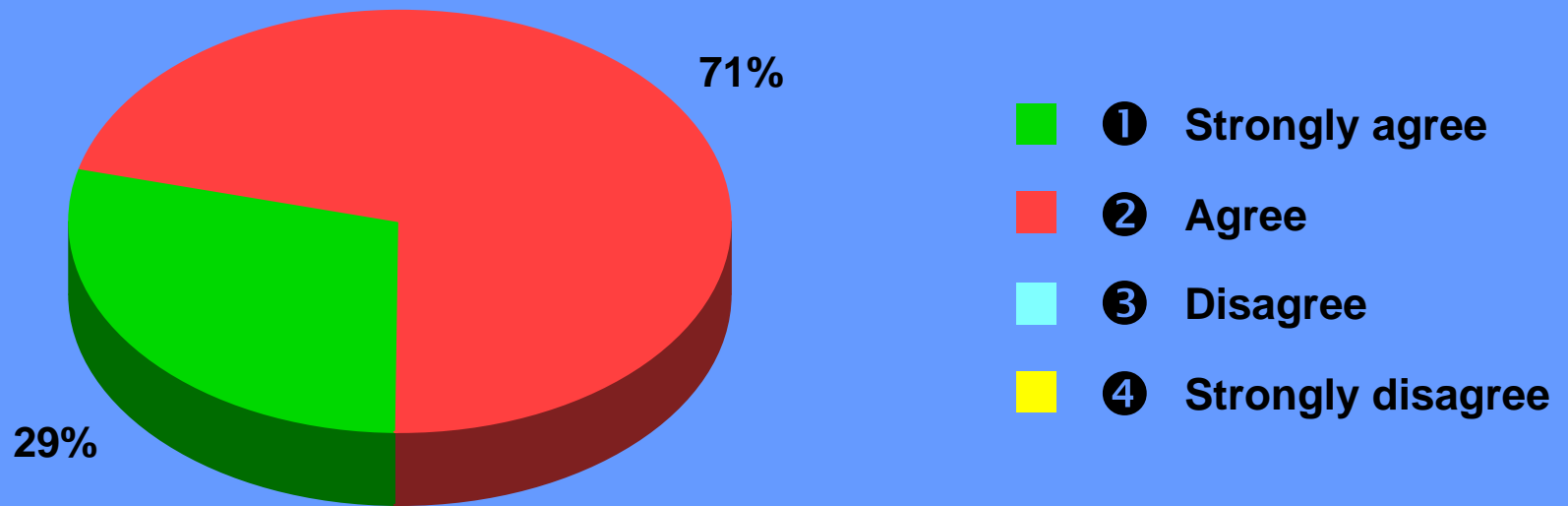

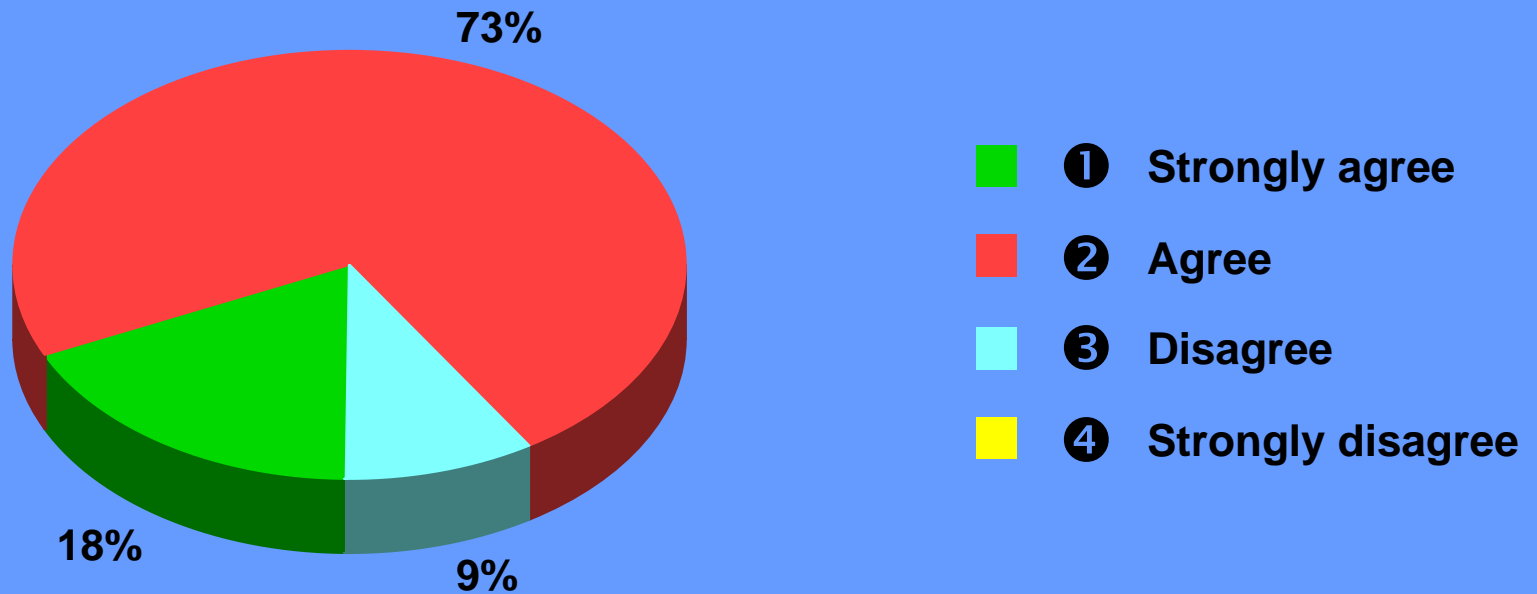

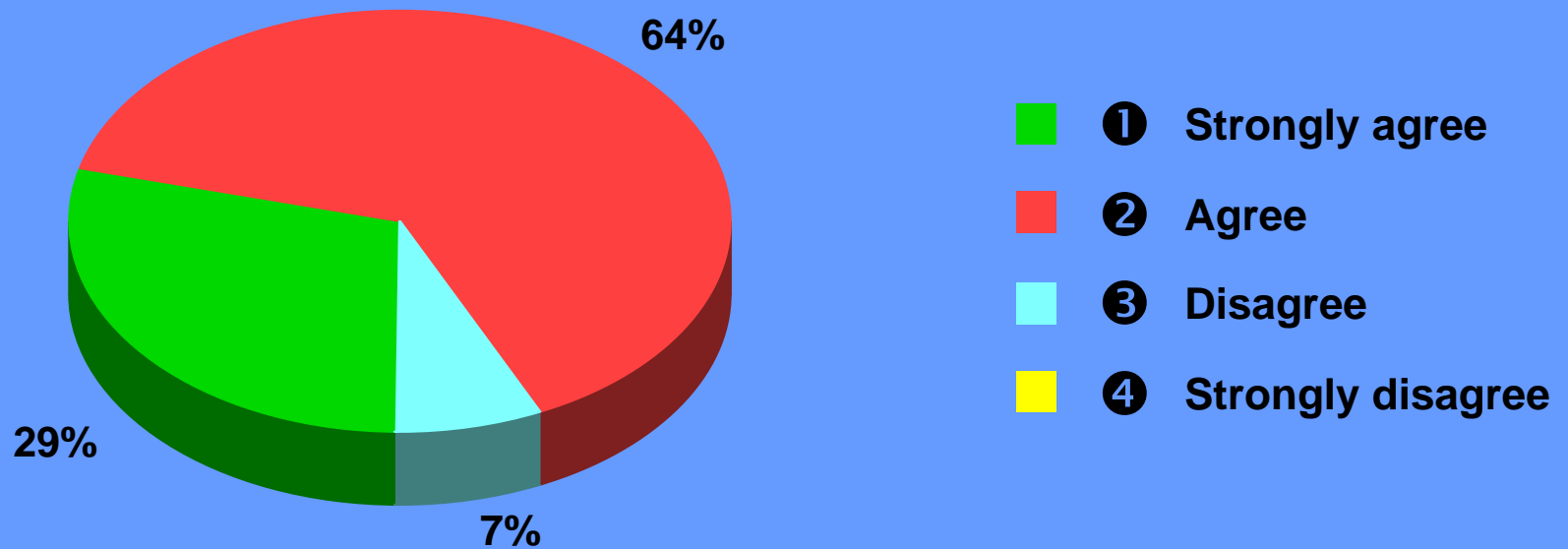

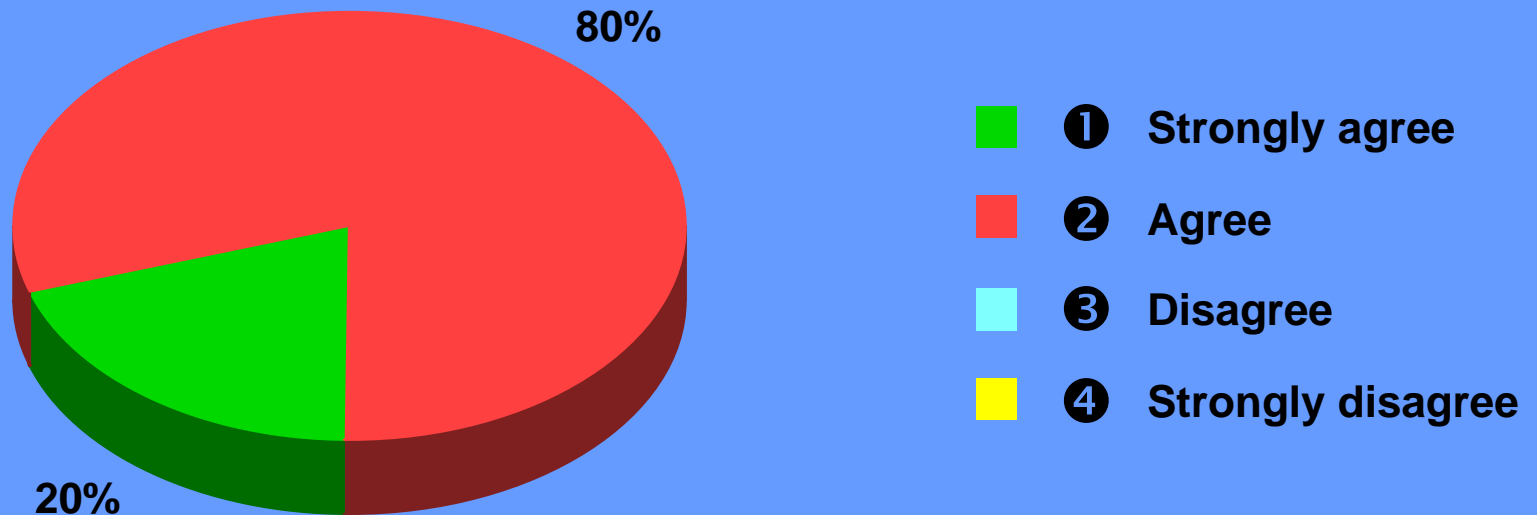

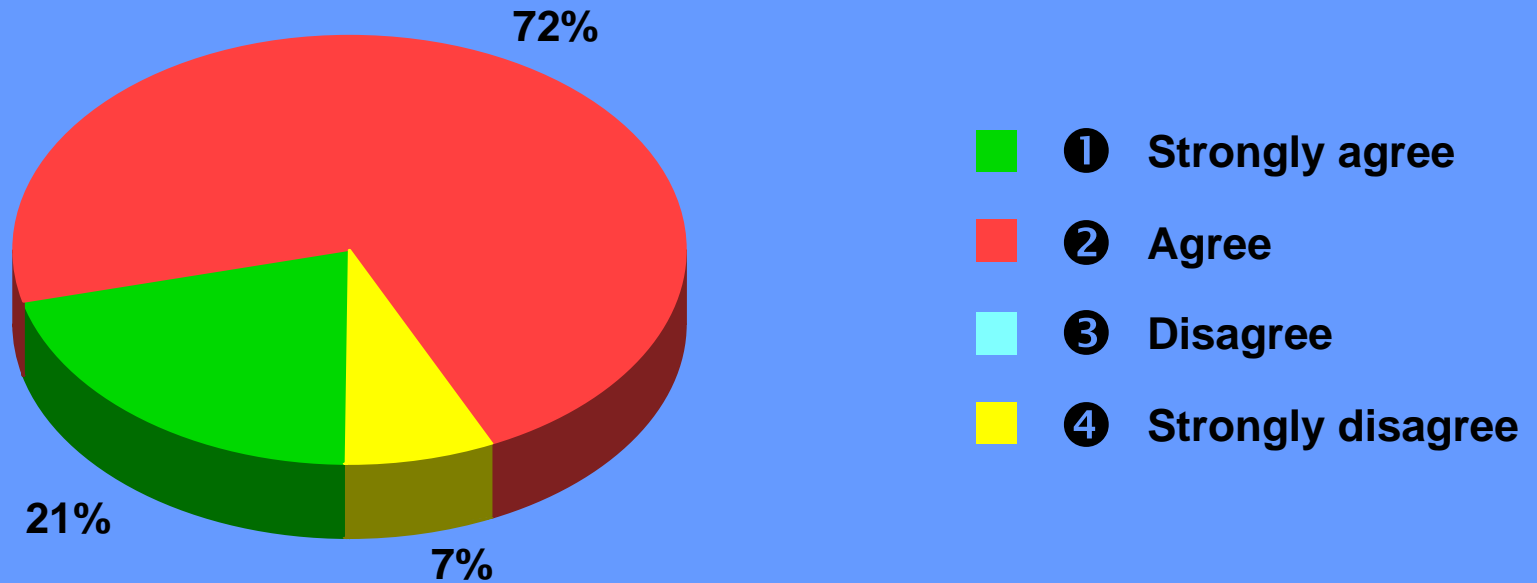

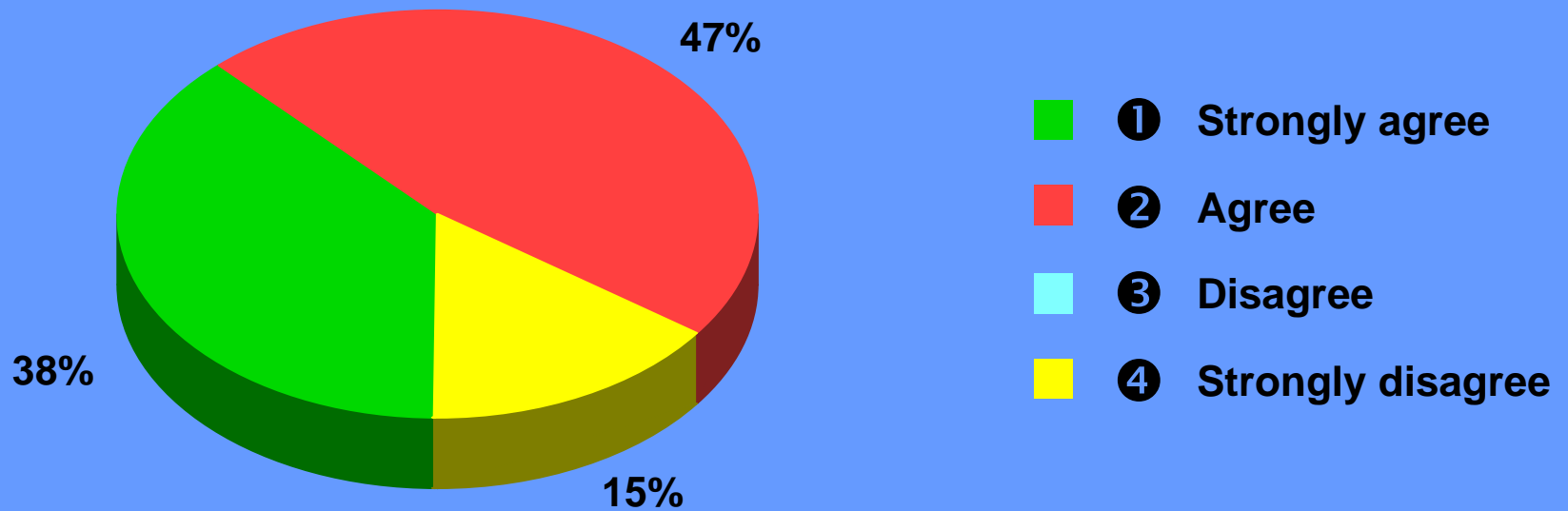

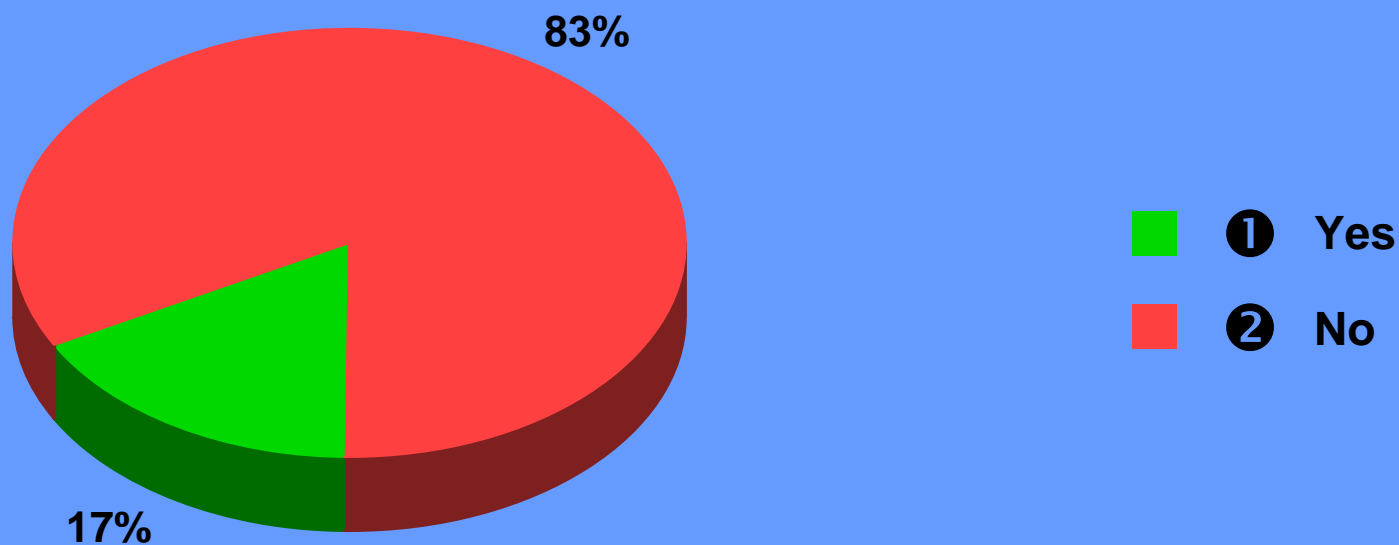

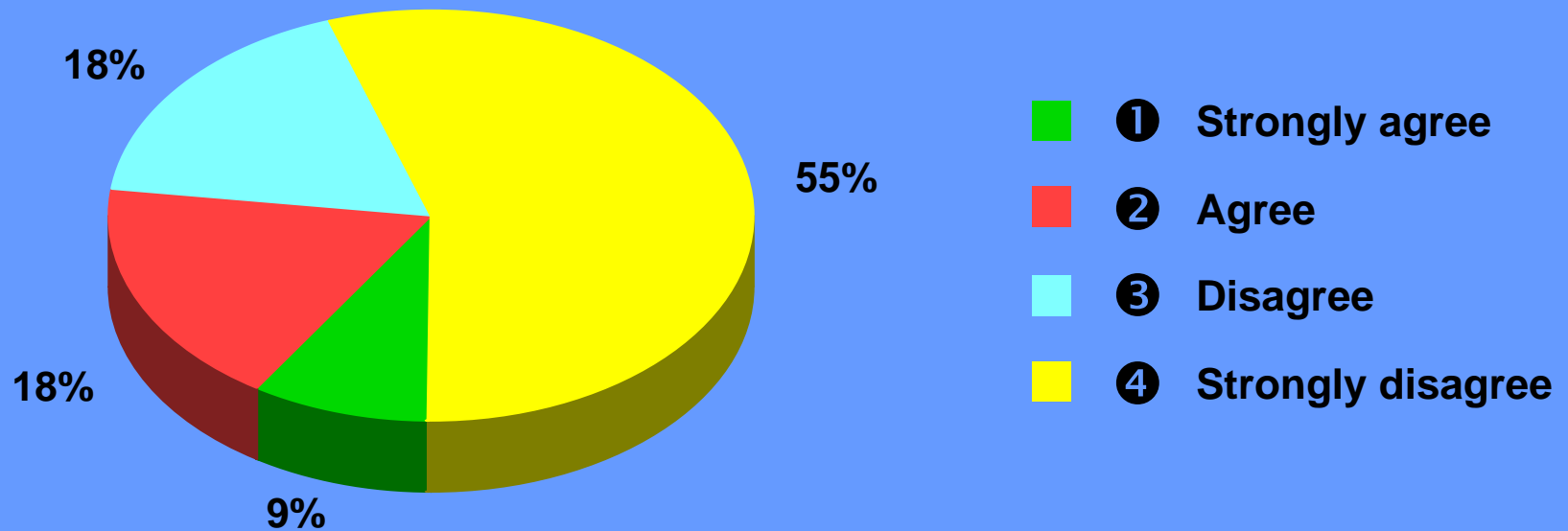
